

Charge : Violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article

Specification

Charge I: Conspiracy: The accused did conspire on or about 29 June 1964 with Ctl LOCKERT to make as many of the Chiefs, present here today, drunk and/or sick by serving them the wrong drinks.

Charge II: Contempt: In that the accused did make the statement that when a man puts on the hard hat he forges how it feels to be a white hat and that all chiefs treat blue jackets as some lowly being and without brotherly love.

Charge III: Cruelty: In that the accused on or about 2 July 1964 did order, three persons subject to his orders, to accompany him to the local small stores and forced them to watch as he tried on and purchased portions of a Chief's uniform.

Charge IV: Extortion: In that C. C. LOPEZ did on or about 6 April 1964 state that he would kill the Chiefs with kindness in order that he might receive lesser charges.

Charge V: Malingering: In that C. C. LOPEZ CTCA-P2 did receive the mid-watch of this morning, 16 July 1964, off from his division officer by stating to that gentleman that some Chief ordered him to appear in the operations spaces this morning at 0800.
